"CANCER CARE: NURSING PERSPECTIVE & RESEARCH"

Cancer is the second leading global cause of death. Statistics show that the number of Indians suffering from cancer is on the rise and will reach a predictable mark of 29.8 million in 2025 from 26.7 million in 2021. Statistics also show that the projected rate was 94.1 per 100,000 in men and 103.6 per 100,000 among women in the year 2020 (Cancer Statistics Report, 2020). New and challenging problems like rapid urbanization, ageing population, inactive and unhealthy lifestyles, indoor and outdoor air pollution, etc., are some of the responsible factors for the emerging cancer burden across the globe. The impact is majorly on middle-to-low socio-economic countries including India.

Research thus helped to accumulate extensive knowledge about the biological processes involved in cancer onset, growth, and spread in the body. Nurse Researchers around the world are working towards finding better ways to prevent, detect and care during cancer and ensure that survivors live longer with better lives. Clinical research is essential for continually improving standards of patient care.

Quality and reproducibility of data are two of the key principles of ethically sound research. All data must be accurate and complete for the results of the study to be valid, and nurse researchers often have the responsibility towards this aspect. This requires attention to detail, a meticulous approach and a high level of integrity.

Nursing research conferences on cancer will help to increase the knowledge & skill of nurses. It will also lead to the accumulation of extensive knowledge about the biological process involved in the onset & growth of the disease as well as the multi disciplinary approach in cancer treatment.

Abstracts should be well organized, brief and relevant with key words.

Requirements for Submission of Abstract:

- Abstract should include title of the study, objectives, methodology, data analysis and conclusion.
- Maximum 300-350 words.
- Font size 12, Times New Roman/Arial, Single space .

Guidelines for the Poster Presentation

- The title of the poster should be the same as that of approved abstract.
- Size of the poster should be 3 feet x 3 feet on flexi material with white base.
- Organize the posters in section: Introduction, objectives, material and methods, results & conclusion.
- Poster should be brought in person.

Note : Abstracts of both paper & poster need to be submitted through e-mail on or before 30th September 2022. Abstract should accompany personal details like name, designation, and passport size photo on a separate page. Abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee and acceptance will be communicated by email.
