## **NRSI SEED GRANTS FOR RESEARCH (NSGR)**

The Nursing Research Society of India (NRSI) provides financial assistance to promote research work in the fields of nursing to encourage entire nursing fraternity, especially the life-members of NRSI, whether pursuing or completed their M.Sc. nursing or Ph. D and nurses working in the clinical areas to avail research funding of up to 15 thousand INR. Inter-disciplinary, inter-institutional proposals are also encouraged.

These grants are outcome based. It is expected that one or more quality research paper/s (NRSI Journal or Web of Science or Scopus indexed with due acknowledgement of NRSI), and/or conference presentations at NRSI annual conference are obtained as outcomes.

Life-members of NRSI can apply for seed funding to explore new ideas, which have not received any favorable response from Government agencies.

The procedure and calendar to submit the Research Proposal is as mentioned below

1.	Invite Research Proposal/s ( As per Proforma)	1 <sup>st</sup> January/ 1 <sup>st</sup> July
2.	Last date for submission of Research Proposal (In Hard copy and soft copy to NRSI Office)	15 <sup>th</sup> February/ 15 <sup>th</sup> August
3.	Compilation of Received Research Proposal	25 <sup>th</sup> February/25 <sup>th</sup> August
4.	Interaction with Principal Investigator and Review Committee of NRSI	25 <sup>th</sup> Feb. to 10 <sup>th</sup> March/ 25 <sup>th</sup> August to 10 <sup>th</sup> September
5.	Submission of Report of the Review Committee to NRSI	
6.	Approval of the research proposal/s by NRSI	15 <sup>th</sup> March/ 15 <sup>th</sup> September
7.	Commencement of Research Projects	1 <sup>st</sup> April/ 1 <sup>st</sup> October

Note:

- All the NSGR shall be regularly reviewed by a committee every 6 months.
- The grants shall be released based on actual expenses at the end of project (The project considered ended when final manuscript accepted for publication)
